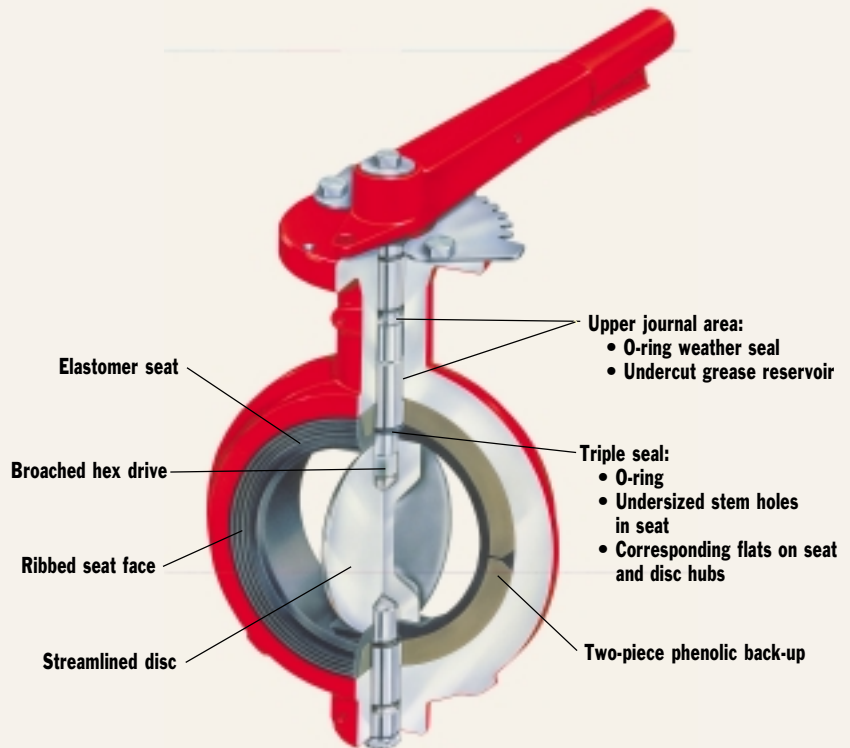

Weco Butterfly Valves have been delivering reliable service in harsh oilfield applications for over 25 years. Because there are no in-line screws, pins, or bolts, little or no maintenance is required during field operations. If a Weco valve should require repair, FMC offers the industry's most comprehensive valve refurbishment program.

Once FMC's specially trained service technicians have disassembled the valve, all parts are cleaned and inspected for undue wear and damage. Different trims can be requested to match changing operating requirements. Items normally replaced during the reconditioning process include:

- Seat
- Disc
- Upper and lower spirol pins
- O-rings
- Lock washers
- Screws
- Nuts

NOTE: Normal cleaning, such as flushing to prevent product from building up and restricting the movement of the disc, will increase the life of the valve.
